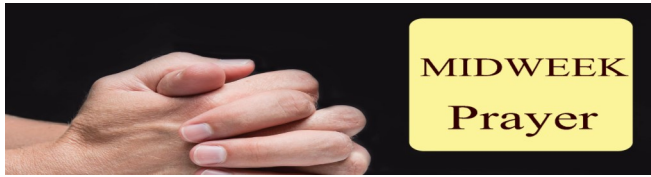
⇒**OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD:** The OCC is collecting school supplies with a special need for notebooks and markers in the month of August.
