

#### A Powerful Gospel

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

Confidence and potential are closely tied together. When you often lose, your evaluation of your potential decreases. It becomes hard to resist the conclusion that you are likely to lose, but a proven winner enters every contest confident that victory is in their grasp. As the Apostle Paul wrote to the Christians in Rome, he expressed full confidence in the power of the gospel. Why? Because he had seen Jesus change lives everywhere he had gone, no matter who they were or where they were from. The gospel changes lives.

We are going to begin the year exploring the power of the gospel. No book in Scripture outlines the powerful, life changing gospel as thoroughly and clearly as the book of Romans. We're going to study the first three chapters together on Sunday morning. And on Wednesday nights, I will be teaching a history series on the Reformation, a period of time during which the church wrestled with itself over what the gospel is and how the church should proclaim it. The stories of the Reformation will give us greater insight into the gospel, into the teachings of Scripture, and into how we can live out the gospel in our own day. Join us on Wednesday nights or listen to the messages posted on our website every week.

Let us make 2025 a year in which we confidently proclaim the good news of the gospel.




